Welcome to the 2025 MSEA Minecraft build challenge! Please read this document for information on rules and registration for this event.

REGISTRATION / COACHES' MEETING

There will be a meeting for coaches on Tuesday, January 28th at 7:00 PM on the MSEA Discord. Attendance at the meeting is required for teams interested in participating. If you are not yet on the MSEA Discord please email commissioner James Young at senioryears@msea.gg for access.

Registration deadline is February 2nd at 5:30 pm

RULES:

1. Please take a moment to review the general MSEA Senior Years rules included at the end of this document. These rules include important information regarding student eligibility and conduct.
2. Schools must be members in good standing with MSEA. If your school is not currently a member please visit <https://msea.gg/membership> for more information.
3. Teams can consist of up to 5 students. Solo players are allowed. It will be challenging for an individual student to complete the build on their own.
4. Maximum 3 teams per school. Additional teams may be allowed based on the total number of registrations. Please contact the commissioner directly via Discord or email about registering additional teams.
5. The build challenge will last from Feb 3 – 28.
6. At 9:00 am on Feb 3 the coaches will receive the theme, criteria, and rubric for this year's build via the email they used to register their teams.
7. Only usage of Minecraft Education Edition is allowed.
8. Creative mode, command blocks, use of Agent, and cheats enabled mode are allowed.
9. Mods external to Minecraft Education Edition are not allowed.
10. You may not modify the Minecraft world, presentation file, or source/citation file between date of submission and the presentation date.

MID SEASON CHECK-IN



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In order to help with planning of the live presentation event we will be adding a mid season check in date on February 18th. Coaches are asked to send in the work their team has completed thus far. Items should be sent directly to the commissioner at amauthe@retsd.mb.ca **Incomplete items are allowed (and encouraged)**. This could include any of the following items:

- Minecraft World File
- Presentation File (Powerpoint / Google Slides / Prezi / etc.)
- List of sources used for research and references (please use APA format)
- Other planning documents (Shared Google Docs, Onenote files, etc.)

Sending in these files is **not mandatory**. However, the submission of these items may be taken into consideration in the event of a tie.

FINAL SUBMISSION

Teams must submit the following files by email to amauthe@retsd.mb.ca before 5:30 pm on Feb 28th.

1. Minecraft World File
2. Presentation File (Powerpoint / Google Slides / Prezi / etc.)
3. List of sources used for research and references (please use APA format)

PRESENTATION

Presentation Date: Early March – Date to be finalized soon

Presentation Location : To be determined

Presentations will be done in front of a live audience and panel of judges and should fulfill the following criteria

- 8 to 12 minutes in length with up to an additional 3 minutes for a question period
- Include a live walkthrough of the Minecraft world
- Live delivery of the presentation file
- All members should participate in some way
- Additional criteria will be outlined in the judging rubric (sent out on February 3rd)



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With this format, each group may answer any questions that the judges may have and guide the judges through the build in a dynamic, interactive process.

If attending the event in person creates a barrier for your team due to travel distance please contact the commissioner via email or Discord. Our preference is for teams to participate in person, however we may be able to make accommodations.
